
Around a Star Mystery - Introduction By Cindy Mccoy

Background - 1-1/4 yards (green in sample)

Color #1 - 1/3 yard (red in sample)

Color #2 - 1/3 yard (holly print in sample)

Color #3 - 1/2 yard

Batting: 40" x 40" Backing: 40" x 40" Binding: 1/3 yard

You will need a good contrast between the background fabric and the others. For colors #1, #2, and #3, use any colors you love working with. All 3 colors must be totally different from one another. It is also good to use a different color family for each. This means, for example, that you would not choose two blues unless there is a strong contrast between them. It is best not to use directional fabrics such as stripes.
