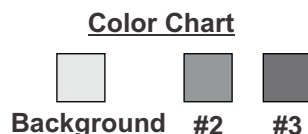


# Around a Star Mystery - Step 6

*This month, it's a bit of a double-take. We'll make a mirror image of the unit we made in Step 5! Make sure you refer to the color chart in Step 1 and below when cutting fabrics.*

## Cutting the Fabric

Name	Qty	Size	Color
Strip A	4	6-1/2" x 9-1/2"	background
Block B	4	3-1/2" square	color #2
Block C	4	6-1/2" square	color #3
Block D	4	3-1/2" square	background

Using a washable pen, draw a line from corner to corner on the back of all B blocks, C blocks, and D blocks (Figure 1).

## Making the Strip

Take one Block B (with drawn line) and one Strip A and place them right sides together (Figure 2). Stitch along the marked line (Figure 2). Trim away the corner leaving a 1/4" seam (Figure 3). Open the strip and press seam toward Strip A. The strip should look like Figure 4.

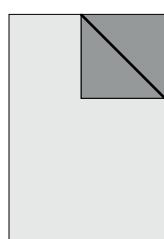

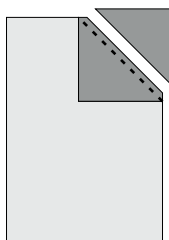

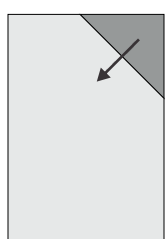

Take the strip and one Block C and place them right sides together (Figure 5). Stitch along the marked line (Figure 5). Trim away the corner leaving a 1/4" seam (Figure 6). Open the strip and press toward Block C. The strip should look like Figure 7.

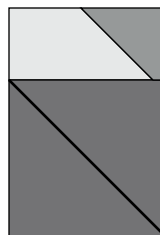

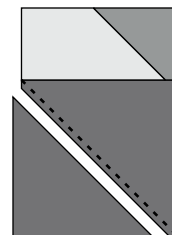

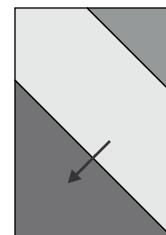

Take the strip and one Block D and place them right sides together (Figure 8). Stitch along the marked line (Figure 8). Trim away the corner leaving a 1/4" seam (Figure 9). Open the strip and press toward Block D. Part F should look like Figure 10.

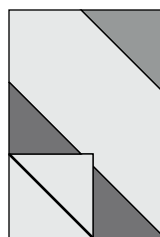

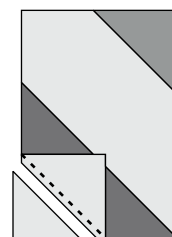

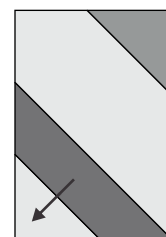

Part F

Make a total of 4 (four) Part F.

Square all strips to 6-1/2" x 9-1/2".

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
