Special Instructions - All seams are 1/4".

Parts Needed

Part A from step 1, as shown in Figure 1.

Part D from step 4, as shown in Figure 2.

Part G from step 7, as shown in Figure 3.

Making the Top





Figure 4 Strip A

Make Strip A by sewing Part D, Part G, and Part D together (Figure 4). Press seams toward Part D.

Make a total of 2 (two) Strip A.

Make Strip B by sewing Part G, Part A, and Part G together (Figure 5). Press seams toward Part A.

Strip B

Make the top by sewing Strip A, Strip B, and Strip A together (Figure 6). Press seams toward Strip A or press seams open.



The completed quilt top should measure 36-1/2" x 36-1/2".

Quilt Sandwich

Layer quilt backing, batting, and quilt top together and hand or pin baste.

Quilting

You can guilt as you wish or in the ditch for each block.

Binding

Trim the backing and batting to the size of the top.

Measure the perimeter of your quilt and add another 12". Cut 4 (four) 2-1/2" strips across the WOF and stitch them together on a diagonal to have a strip the length calculated.

Stitch the binding to the quilt and use your favorite method to join the ends. Turn the binding to back and hand-stitch.

Label

Remember to make a label for your quilt.

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
