Materials List

All cuts based on usable 40" wide, prewashed 100% cotton fabrics

- 1-1/2 yds Fabric A (brown in sample)
- 1-3/8 yds Fabric B (gold in sample)
- 1-1/4 yds Fabric C (dark green in sample)
- 1 yd Fabric D (light green in sample)
- 3/4 yd Fabric E (dark gold in sample)
- 5/8 yd Fabric F (tan in sample)
- 3/8 yd Fabric G (orange in sample)
- 1/4 yd Fabric H (medium green in sample)
- 4-7/8 yds backing and binding
- 61" x 85" piece of batting
