

9-Patch Rows - Introduction

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This project will be a lot of fun! We are going to make 9-Patch blocks and rows that change. Jump on in beginners and hone your skills.

Special Instructions

All seams are 1/4".

Fabric Needed:

All cuts based on usable 40" wide, prewashed 100% cotton fabrics

Each row will use the same Background fabric plus one or two accent fabrics (Color #1 and Color #2). You can use the same accent fabrics for each row or different ones per row. We will be making 3" squares and half-square triangles so I suggest medium to small prints for the accent fabrics.

Background: 5 yards

NOTE: If you would like to use the same Color #1 and Color #2 for all the rows, then you will need 3-1/3 yards of Color #1 and 1-1/2 yards of Color #2.

Row 1: Color #1 - 2/3 yd

Row 2: Color #1 - 1/2 yd
Color #2 - 1 FQ

Row 3: Color #1 - 1 plump eighth
Color #2 - 1 FQ

Row 4: Color #1 - 1/2 yd
Color #2 - 1 plump eighth

Row 5: Color #1 - 1 FQ
Color #2 - 1 FQ

Row 6: Color #1 - 1/2 yd
Color #2 - 1 plump eighth

Row 7: Color #1 - 1/2 yd
Color #2 - 1 plump eighth

Row 8: Color #1 - 1/2 yd
Color #2 - 1 FQ

Row 9: Color #1 - 1 FQ
Color #2 - 1 plump eighth

Row 10: Color #1 - 1 plump eighth
Color #2 - 1 FQ

Border: 1-1/2 yds

Backing: 7-1/4 yds

Batting: 86" x 101"

Binding: 3/4 yd

A plump eighth (11" x 18") is half of a FQ (18" x 22")
