Materials List

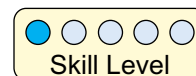
All cuts based on usable 40" wide, prewashed 100% cotton fabrics

- 1/2 yd background fabric
- 1 fat quarter accent fabric (checkerboard border)
- 9" square brown fabric (basket)
- 9" square red fabric (hearts)
- 6" square dk blue fabric (flower petals)
- 4" square lt blue fabric (flower petals)
- 4" square lt purple fabric (flower petals)
- 4" square dk purple fabric (flower petals)
- 4" square lt pink fabric (flower petals)
- 4" square dk pink fabric (flower center)
- 4" square yellow fabric (flower centers)
- 4" square green fabric (leaves)
- 1/4 yd fabric for binding
- 23" x 23" piece for backing
- 23" x 23" piece of batting
- 6" square freezer papers for flower petals
- 1 (one) 8-1/2" x 11" freezer paper sheet to make one flower.
- 1/2 yd optional tear-away stabilizer for machine appliqué
- 1/2 yd optional paper-backed fusible web for machine appliqué
