Winter Mystery Quilt Schedule

Step 1:

- Choose the type of quilt to make, shop for fabrics, and do some cutting

Step 2:

- Make the units and do some more cutting

Step 3:

- Choose the block layout, choose the quilt top layout, shop for fabrics, do some more cutting, and assemble the quilt top center

Step 4:

- Add borders, layer, quilt, bind, and label
