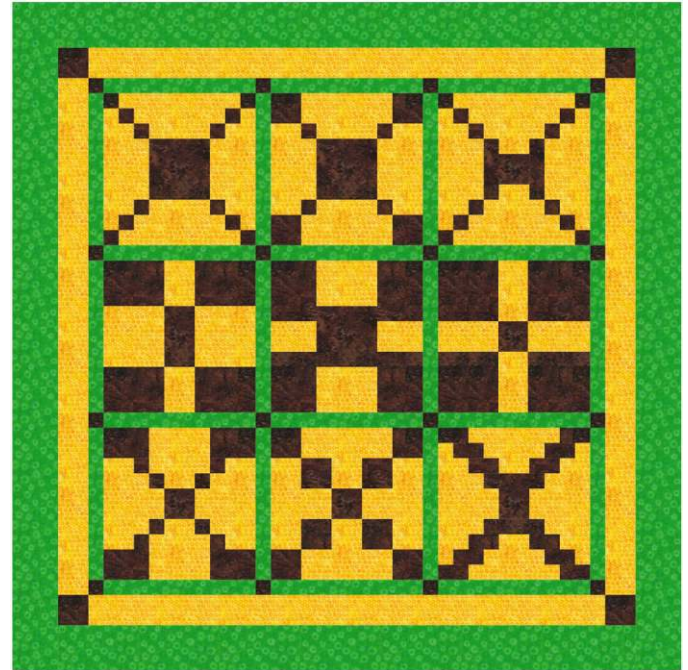

## Materials List

All cuts based on usable 40" wide, prewashed 100% cotton fabrics

- 1-1/8 yds Fabric A (yellow in sample)
- 3/4 yd Fabric B (brown in sample)
- 1 yd Fabric C (green in sample)
- 1/2 yd binding fabric
- 2-7/8 yds backing fabric
- 50" x 50" piece of batting
- Quart-sized plastic zipper bags (about 18)
