## Materials

All cuts based on usable 40" wide, prewashed 100% cotton fabrics

- 1-1/4 yds Fabric A (green in sample)
- 1-5/8 yds Fabric B (brown in sample)
- 1-1/8 yds Fabric C (cream in sample)
- 1/2 yd Fabric D (orange in sample)
- 1/2 yd binding
- 2-5/8 yds for backing
- 56" x 60" piece of batting
