Fabric Requirements

Finished size: 30-1/2" x 30-1/2"

All cuts based on usable 40" wide, prewashed 100% cotton fabrics

- 1/2 yd Fabric A (light)
- 1-1/8 yd Fabric B (background and border)
- 1/2 yd Fabric C (contrast to the light and dark)
- 3/8 yd Fabric D (dark)
- 3/8 yd binding
- 1 yd for backing
- 34" x 34" piece of batting
